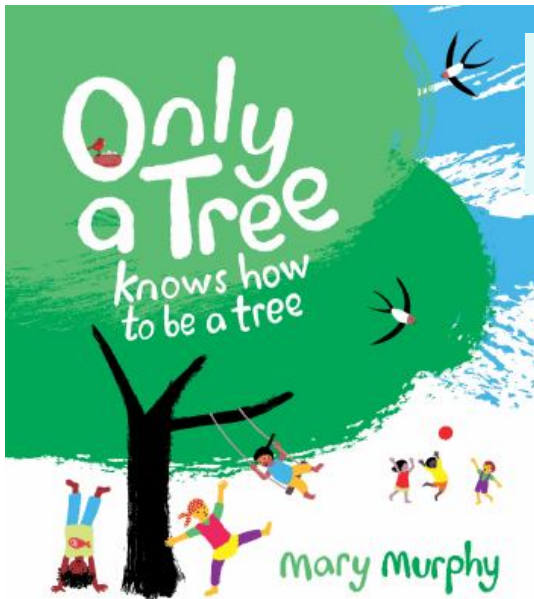

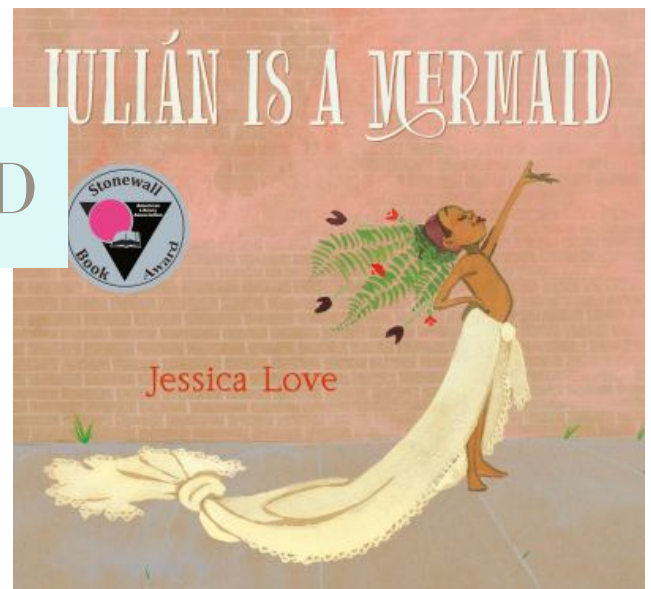


ONLY A TREE KNOWS HOW TO BE A TREE

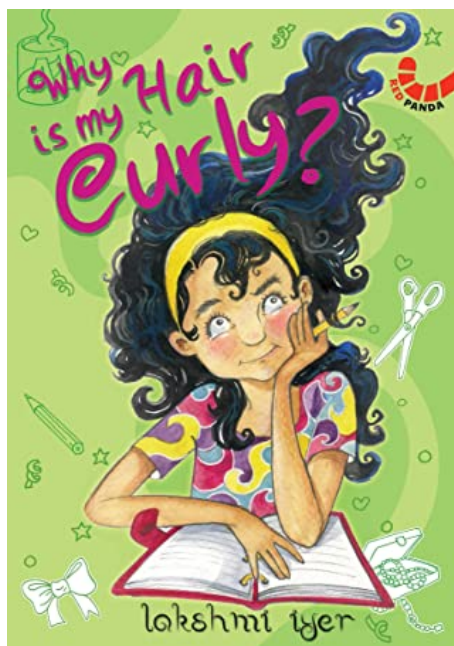

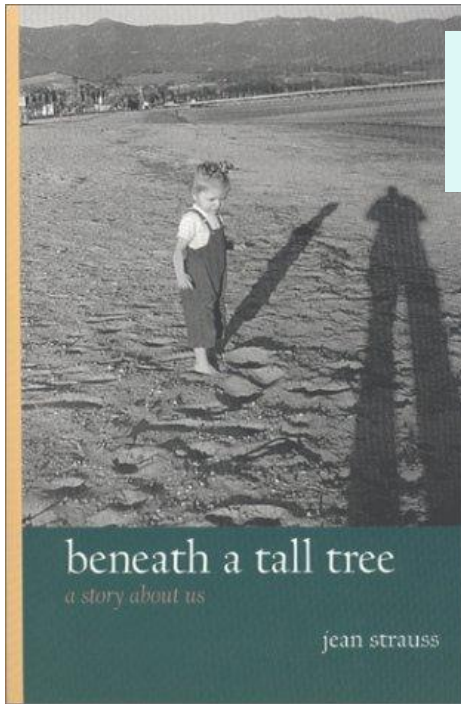

WHY IS MY HAIR CURLY?

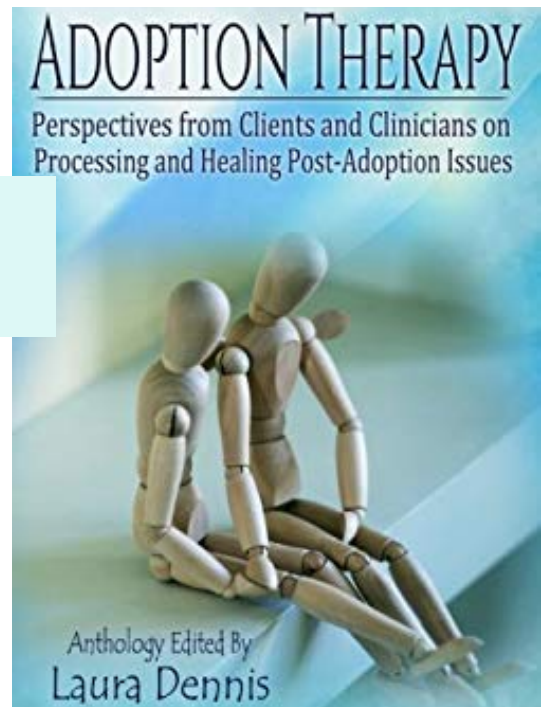

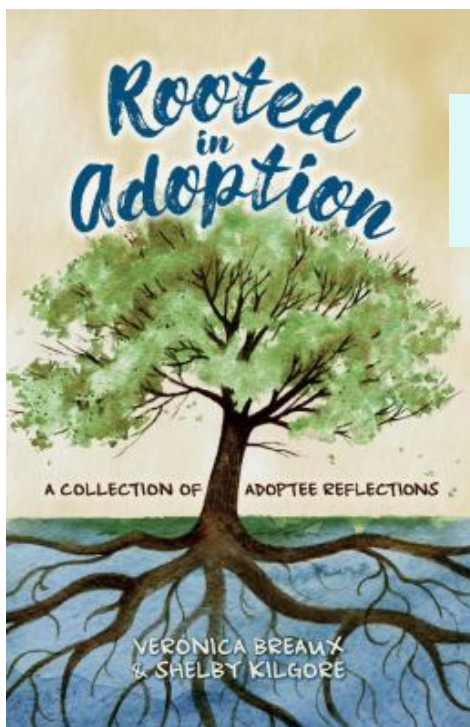
