While we share in the concern for the people of Afghanistan, adoption from the country is not possible at this time; nor do we anticipate it will be possible for the foreseeable future. We also do not anticipate a need for foster care, as the children being evacuated are arriving with their parents or other extended family. If there are children who are evacuated on their own, they are coming to biological relatives in the US or will be placed with members of the Afghan Muslim community.
