#### **Estimated Costs Paid to Other Entities**

This estimate does not include fees paid to in country attorney, orphanage, or governmental organizations. FAC will work with you and your in country provider(s) to determine these fees and will provide a supplemental fee agreement to stipulate these fees and their due date(s) to the best of the agency's ability prior to the initiation of adoption services. 96.40(b).

\*Should you receive a Request for Evidence at any point in your adoption process, both Dempsey Law and Frank Adoption may charge an additional fee to compile and submit a response, dependent on the nature of the request.

All invoices are due within 30 days of issue, as noted directly on the invoice. After 30 days, a 5% late fee will be charged and a second invoice issued, to be paid within a second 30 days. Please know that failure to pay within the allotted time frame may cause Frank Adoption Center to stop or delay your adoption/visa process or to cancel your contract and cease to serve as your Primary Provider. All invoices must be paid in full prior to our filing your child's US visa application.

Payments made to Frank Adoption Center can be made via personal or bank check; PayPal; credit card; or Zelle. Instructions for payment methods can be found on your invoice. Please note that PayPal; Stripe (the credit card processing service); and Zelle charge a 1-3% fee. Should you choose to pay using one of these methods, FAC will calculate this service fee once your final payment is received and you will be sent an invoice for this total. We ask that you pay this invoice via personal or bank check.

### **Further Explanation of Fees:**

### **Application Fee......\$200**

Due with submission of Application; at this time, we also ask that you submit any information related to the child(ren) you intend to adopt and/or your process in country. This fee is for adoption services provided in the United States. 96.40(b)(2).

While we will likely issue a preliminary approval upon initial review of your application, a formal approval will not be given until:

- Your initial invoice of \$5,500 has been paid
- A Domestic Provider Agreement has been executed between Frank Adoption Center and your Home StudyAgency
- A complete Foreign Supervised Provider file has been established (if your adoption has not yet been finalized in country) OR
- An attorney verification letter has been received or, if you did not utilize the services of an attorney in country, a complete review of documents has been done by an attorney in country (if your adoption is already final in country) (96.46(c)

### Agency Fee 1... \$5,000

You will be billed for this fee once hard copies of your Application and signed Fee and Placing Agreements are received. Payment is due within 30 days of receipt and must be received in order to formally approve your application.

Includes confirmation of attorney verification documents OR agreement with overseas attorney/agency as Foreign Supervised Provider and Supervisory Agreements, if necessary, with any other involved parties, including Home Study agency. This fee is for adoption services provided in the United States. 96.40(b)(2).

## Monitoring and Oversight Fee ......\$500/child

You will be billed for this fee once your application and signed fee and placing agreements are received. The amount billed will be based on the number of children listed on your initial application. Payment is due within 30 days of receipt and must be received in order to formally approve your application.

This is a fee that will be paid by Frank Adoption Center directly to Intercountry Adoption Accreditation and MaintenanceEntity (IAAME). Frank Adoption Center does not dictate this fee, nor do we have the authority to change or alter it in anyway. It is non-refundable, regardless of the outcome of a family's adoption. This fee is for adoption services provided in the United States. 96.40(b)(2).

## In Country Attorney Review and Approval Fee......Approx. \$500 - \$2,500\*

If a fee is requested of the attorney in country, you will be billed for this fee once all terms are agreed upon. Payment is due within 30 days and must be received in order to formally approve your application.

Frank Adoption Center may ask for a Legal Opinion Letter and/or confirmation of adoption from an attorney in country. Additional services may include gathering any documents from the Ministry, Court or any other party that may be needed in relation to your adoption. Review will ensure your documents meet the legal requirements of the country and ensure we are submitting a detailed file to US officials when filing for your child's US visa. Frank Adoption Center may be able to refer you to an attorney in country or will ask that you identify such provider. If needed, a formal agreement will be put in place, dictating services and payment prior to any money being sent. You will pay Frank this fee to be wired to the in- country attorney. This is a fee for foreign country program expenses. 96.40(b)(3).

# In Country Investigation Fee.....\$250/unrelated child\*

\*if applicable

If an investigation is deemed necessary, you will be billed for this fee once all terms are agreed upon. Payment is due within 30 days and must be received in order to formally approve your application.

Based on initial paperwork review and input from your in country attorney, Frank Adoption Center may partner with an independent 3<sup>rd</sup> party organization (typically an NGO) to conduct a non-biased investigation into your child's history. This is meant to address any concerns or issues prior to your moving forward and to meet FAC's legal and ethical obligation to ensure international adoption is truly in a child's best interest. Investigation may include document review; interviews with Ministry officials; orphanage staff; biological family and/or caregivers. FAC will be given a formal written report once an investigation is complete and relevant details will be shared directly with you. Based on the findings of this investigation, FAC along with Dempsey Law, may conclude a case is no longer viable and services will be terminated. A written agreement will be put in place with the 3<sup>rd</sup> party organization, detailing services and expenses and a fee will be agreed upon prior to your being charged. You will pay Frank this fee to be wired to the in- country attorney. This is a fee for foreign country program expenses. 96.40(b)(3).

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You will be billed for this fee once your home study draft has been submitted to Frank Adoption Center for review. Payment is due within 30 days of receipt.

Includes review of Home Study and verification of all parent training required up to this point. Includes any work remaining towards completion of adoption file in country, including provision of supervisory activities to in country partners and further review, verification and obtaining of foreign documents. This fee is for adoption services provided in the United States. 96.40(b)(2).

<u>Please note that this does not include review and response to any Request for Evidence or Notice of Intent to Deny potentially received at this stage.</u>

#### Hague Administration Fee.....\$1,000

You will be billed for this fee once your home study draft has been submitted to Frank Adoption Center for review. Payment is due within 30 days of receipt.

This fee is for the services and tasks associated with maintaining Hague compliance. This fee is for adoption services provided in the United States. 96.40(b)(2).

## Post Adoption Report Deposit.....\$1,000

You will be billed for this fee once your home study draft has been submitted to Frank Adoption Center for review. Payment is due within 30 days of receipt.

Post Adoption Reports are vital to ensure countries remain open for adoption to the US. At minimum, families will be asked to complete visits/reports by a social worker at 3 and 6 months after arrival. In addition, your state and/or child'scountry may have their own specific requirements. This is applicable for relative cases and non-relative cases. Once allPost Adoption Reports have been completed and have been sent to FAC and/or to the correct in country entity, this feewill be refunded to you. This fee is for adoption services provided in the United States. 96.40(b)(2).

### Sibling Fee.....\$2,000

If applicable, you will be billed for this fee once your home study draft has been submitted to Frank Adoption Center for review. Payment is due within 30 days of receipt.

This fee applies only to families adopting more than 1 child. The fee is per adoptive family, not per child, and will be charged only once regardless of the number of children being adopted and is not dependent on their biological sibling status. This fee is for adoption services provided in the United States. 96.40(b)(2).

## Transfer Cost Fee ...... varies

You will be billed for this fee once your I600/I800 filing has been submitted to USCIS. Payment is due within 30 days of receipt.

This fee will reimburse FAC for the costs of wire transfers to recipients in country; of bank transfer costs; and of Fed Ex/UPS/DHL fees (including those documents sent by Dempsey Law). Families will be provided with invoices/receipts of all charges directly from the paid entity. This fee is for document expenses. 96.40(b)(5).

Please be aware that USCIS may change their fees at any time. If this happens, we will notify you as soon as possible as to how you may be impacted by the change.

**US Visa Fee ......\$325** 

Payable to US Department of Homeland Security prior to obtaining child's US visa. This fee may change at the discretion of US DOS.

## **DNA Testing Fee......\$1,000**

The need for DNA testing is determined by the US Embassy during the I604 investigation. This testing fee is paid by theadopting family and is typically \$1,000, though this could change based on testing location or Embassy policy change.

### Medical Fees......\$800-1,000/child

Visa Medical Exams are required by the US Embassy after the I604 investigation. This fee is paid by the adopting family to an Embassy approved clinic and is typically \$800-1,000, depending on services needed for the child.

## Child's Passport.....~\$100-300/child

This is an estimated cost and may change depending on your child's country. Families can obtain their child's passport on their own or rely on friends or family to complete this service. Your in country attorney may also be willing to handle this on your behalf.

# Home Study Fee.....varies, estimated at \$1,500-4,000

You must utilize a Hague accredited Home Study agency in your state of residence when possible. You will work directly with this agency and will pay them based on their fee schedule. Your Home Study agency will act as an exempted or supervised provider of Frank Adoption Center. 96.40(b)(1). Frank may provide home study services for North Carolina families. If Frank provides the home study the cost is \$2,000.

### Additional variable costs include:

Medical fees: a medical appointment is required for all children prior to issuance of visa. The appointment must happen at US Embassy approved clinic in country and typically costs between \$800-1,500 per child. This is a third-party fee. 96.40(c)(1).

<u>Passport fee</u>: your child must have a passport issued by his/her country of birth. This fee is variable by country; we willdo our best to determine an estimate for this fee as early in your adoption process as possible. This is a third-party fee. 96.40(c)(1).

<u>Travel expenses</u>: Travel expenses include travel to and from your child's country of birth (know that many countries require more than one trip), as well as cost of food, hotel/lodging, and transportation while there. You may incur additional travel related expenses as your child and any relevant parties (biological family, orphanage staff, in countrypartners) are brought to and from the Embassy for various interviews and appointments. Again, we will do our best todetermine an estimate of these fees as early in your adoption process as possible. These are fees for travel and accommodations. 96.40(c)(2).

While we do not anticipate Frank Adoption Center or our in-country staff being needed to transport witnesses, children or anyone else involved in your case to the Ministry, Court or Embassy, SHOULD THIS BE REQUIRED, a transportation fee may be charged accordingly and must be paid prior to an appointment being made.

Unless specifically noted, all fees paid to in country providers must go through Frank Adoption Center; <u>you should NOT make direct payments</u> to any attorneys, orphanage directors, government officials, or other entity outside of the US.

An Addendum to this Fee Agreement may be provided after initial signing of this document. The Addendum will detail any additional costs associated with your adoption process, in the US or in country, and will be agreed uponby all parties prior to any money being exchanged. This addendum may change as your process continues.

#### **US Based Attorney Fees:**

For all of our cases, Frank Adoption Center partners with Dempsey Law (<a href="https://www.kdempseylaw.com/">https://www.kdempseylaw.com/</a>). Kelly's legal knowledge and adoption expertise plays a vital role in ensuring your visa filing is as comprehensive as possible. After submitting your initial paperwork to Frank Adoption Center, your Application will be shared with Dempsey Law and you will be sent an engagement packet related to the firm's services, along with an initial invoice. This is a third-party fee. 96.40(c)(1).

#### Attorney Fee......\$3,000

This fee will be billed once your home study has been reviewed by Frank Adoption Center. It is due within 30 days of receipt and must be paid prior to your I600 being filed.

This fee includes review of any documents already obtained in country, ensuring they meet the legal standards of both thesending country and the US. It also includes assistance with filing of the I600A/I800A (if needed) and follow up related to approval and expiration dates as your case moves forward. This fee includes compilation of a child's full I600/I800 filing, along with consultation and follow up after submissionand as you prepare for your child's and later your own visa interview with the US Embassy. This is a third-party fee. 96.40(c)(1).

### **Sibling Fee – Dempsey Law ...... \$2,000**

This fee is due with Attorney Fee 2 and is billed per family, not per child, regardless of children's biological sibling status. This is a third-party fee. 96.40(c)(1).

Your inability to pay for all or any part of FAC's fee will not be an immediate disqualifying factor in determining your eligibility for adoption.

Should your case not be completed within 18 months of the date your Fee Agreement is signed, FAC may opt to complete a full case review, including updating any documents and ensuring they are submitted to the proper officials inboth the US and in country. Determination as to whether or not this review will be needed will be made by FAC and Dempsey Law and based on a number of factors, including but not limited to: history of adoptions in the country, input from overseas providers, discussion with other agencies working in the country. The fee for this service will be \$1,500.

Frank Adoption Center does not customarily charge additional fees and expenses beyond those disclosed in this document. In the event of additional unforeseen expenses in the foreign country, Frank will disclose the fees and expenses in writing for which the client family will be held responsible; obtain consent from the client family before expending fees in excess of \$1,000; and provide receipts/evidence of how money is spent. These fees may relate to mailing costs, translations, apostille/authentication of documents, child care, contributions, additional medical, visa and interview appointments, and other in country costs.

If your child is residing in a country/orphanage/foster placement that typically relies on financial support from adoptivefamilies, this amount and a payment schedule will be agreed upon prior to funds being sent. All monies will be sent through Frank Adoption and proof of payment will be obtained. Monthly support fee typically ranges from \$100-\$250/month for the duration of the adoption process.

If your child is residing in a country/orphanage/foster placement in which it is customary for families to make a donation once their child's adoption is complete, this information will be disclosed in writing prior to any monies being sent. Proof of payment will be obtained and the reimbursement for such donation will be the responsibility of the adoptive family.

<u>For families living in North Carolina</u>, Frank Adoption Center may be able to complete home study, post adoption/postplacement and re-adoption services. For information on these services, please contact <a href="mailto:mbk@frankadopt.org">mbk@frankadopt.org</a>.

#### **Explanation of Fees**

- **Home study fee:** The home study fee is the expected total fee and estimated expenses for home study preparation and approval. The home study will be prepared by a supervised provider, exempted provider, or approved person and approved as required under § 96.47. 96.40(b)(1).
- Adoption expenses in the United States: The following fees are for adoption expenses in the United States: application fee, agency fees, Hague administration fee, monitoring and oversight fee, dossier fileprep fee, sibling fee agency and post-adoption deposit. These are the expected total fees and estimated expenses for all adoption services other than the home study that will be provided in the United States. This category includes, but is not limited to, personnel costs, administrative overhead, operational costs, training and education, communications and publications costs, and any other costs related to providing adoption services in the United States. 96.40(b)(2).

- Foreign country program expenses: This fee encompasses the expected total fees and estimated expenses for all adoption services that will be provided in the child's country of origin. This category includes, but is not limited to, costs for personnel, administrative overhead, training, education, legal services, and communications, and any other costs related to providing adoption services in the child's country. 96.40(b)(3). This fee is specifically outlined and agreed to in the family-specific fee supplementprovided to the family prior to adoption services. 96.40(b).
- Care of the child: This expected total fee and estimated expenses charged to prospective adoptive parent(s) for the care of the child in the country of origin prior to adoption, including, but not limited to, costs for food, clothing, shelter and medical care; foster care services; orphanage care; and any other services provided directly to the child. 96.40(b)(4). This fee is not applicable, unless specifically outlined and agreed to in the family-specific fee supplement provided to the family prior to adoption services being provided. (96.40(b)).
- Translation and document expenses: The fee is for the expected total fees and estimated expenses forobtaining any necessary documents and for any translation of documents related to the adoption, along with information on whether the family will be expected to pay such costs directly or to third parties, either in the United States or in the child's country of origin, or through the agency or person. This category includes, but is not limited to, costs for obtaining, translating, or copying records or documents required to complete the adoption, costs for the child's court documents, passport, adoption certificate and other documents related to the adoption, and costs for notarizations and certifications. The family will pay this fee to Frank Adoption Center for distribution to third parties. 96.40(b)(5). This fee is not applicable, unless specifically outlined and agreed to in the family-specific fee supplement provided to the family prior to adoption services being provided. (96.40(b)).
- Contributions: This is a fee for any fixed contribution amount or percentage that the family will be expected or required to make to child protection or child welfare service programs in the child's countryof origin country or in the United States. If this fee is applicable it will be provided along with an explanation of the intended use of the contribution and the manner in which the transaction will be recorded and accounted for. 96.40(b)(6). This fee is not applicable, unless specifically outlined and agreed to in the family-specific fee supplement provided to the family prior to adoption services being provided. (96.40(b)).
- **Post-placement and post-adoption reports:** This is a fee for the expected total fees and estimated expenses for any post-placement or post-adoption reports that the agency or person or parent(s) must prepare in light of any requirements of the expected country of origin. 96.40(b)(7). This fee is not applicable, unless specifically outlined and agreed to in the family-specific fee supplement provided tothe family prior to adoption services being provided. (96.40(b)). The cost of post-adoption or post-placement reports may range from \$250 \$1,000 per report.
- Third party fees: These fees are the expected total fees and estimated expenses for services that the family will be responsible to pay directly to a third party that are not otherwise disclosed in the other categories listed above. Such third-party fees include, but are not limited to, fees to competent authorities for services rendered or Central Authority processing fees. These also include legal fees in the United States and other fees listed herein as third-party fees. 96.40(c)(1).

• Travel and accommodation expenses. The fee is the expected total fees and estimated expenses for anytravel, transportation, and accommodation services arranged by the agency or person for the family. These fees and expenses can vary greatly depending on when travel occurs, length of stay in country, preferences of the family. The country specific fees estimate are provided to the family prior to application in the family-specific supplement. 96.40(c)(2). The cost of travel can range from \$1,500 up.

By signing this Fee Agreement, I/we acknowledge having received this Fee Agreement prior to adoption services having been provided by Frank. 96.40(b). I/we understand the expected total fees and estimated expenses and the conditions under which fees or expenses may be charged, waived, reduced, or refunded and of when and how the fees and expenses must be paid. 96.40(a).
